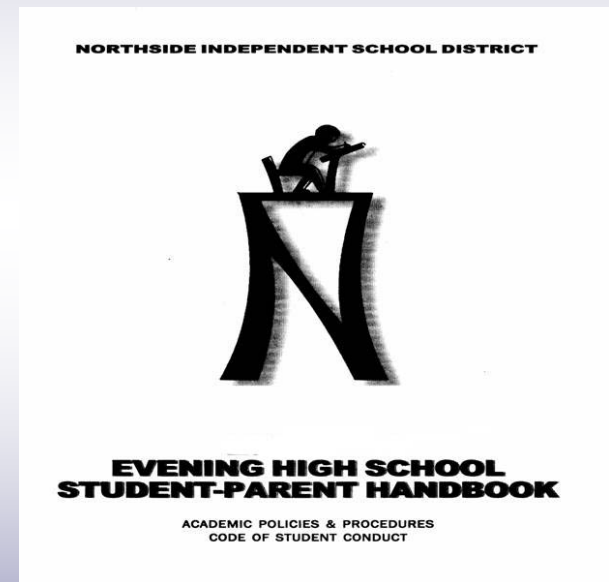
MISSION STATEMENT

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

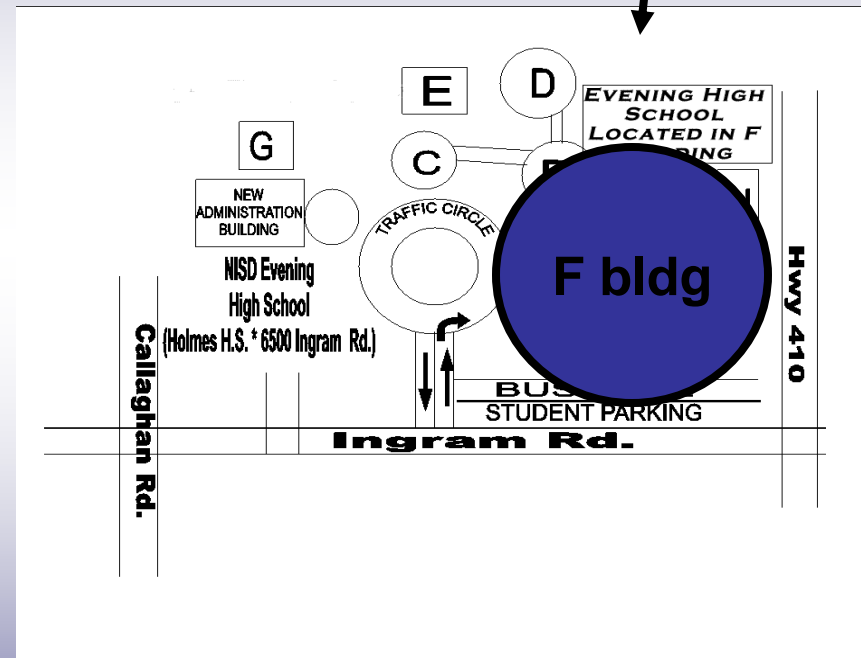
- Know the policies & guidelines in the handbook

CAMPUS

- **Office and most classes**
 - Located in the **F building**
- **“CLOSED CAMPUS”**
 - Student arrives and remains on campus
 - No leaving until classes are finished for the evening
- **NO VISTORS**
 - Visitors are NOT allowed on the campus
 - Parents/guardians must be cleared by the Director

STUDENT CONDUCT

- Students are:
 - Supervised by the classroom teacher or administration at all times
 - Expected to obey all classroom/teacher's rules
- Order must be maintained:
 - An atmosphere of learning is of the utmost importance
 - **Students are to conduct themselves properly**
 - **Students must be in compliance with district policies**
- Consequences for failure to comply to district or classroom rules
 - Disciplinary action
 - **Withdrawal** from EHS without credit or refund



DRESS CODE

- EHS is a **ZERO Tolerance** Campus
- Headwear
 - **NOT** allowed to be worn in the buildings
- Clothing
 - Follow NISD policy as stated in the student handbook
 - **NO shorts of any type** may be worn
- Body piercing jewelry
 - Prohibited, including tongue rings
 - Traditional jewelry worn in the ear is allowed
- Hair styles
 - Unconventional colored or multi-colored hair is **NOT** permitted
 - Mohawk hair styles or spiked hair is **NOT** permitted

STUDENT ATTENDANCE

- Texas Legislature has passed a bill
 - Students must be in attendance **90%** of the days class is held
 - **Three absences** or **more than eight hours** is excessive
 - Students will be withdrawn and receive a failure for excessive absences
 - Students will **NOT** receive credit or a refund if withdrawn
- Teachers will notify the office
 - If a student fails to return to class after break
 - Student will be marked absent and subject to withdrawal
- Absences from school due to work are **NOT** excused
- Leaving EHS before the scheduled dismissal time
 - Students must ask administration for permission to leave early
 - Students **must sign out** in the **office**
 - Will count as time absent

No Credit; No Refund



SEVERE WEATHER ALERT

- In case of severe or extreme weather
 - Students and parents should **NOT** take unnecessary risks to attend Evening High school classes
 - Students will be given an excused absence
- No late work penalty assigned
 - For work that is due on a night of an absence due to bad weather



SCHEDULE

- CLASS HOURS

5:30 - 8:30 p.m.

- TARDIES AFTER BREAK

– Counts as time absent

- BREAK TIME

–20 minute break during the evening

–Students are restricted to the snack bar and patio area

–Students may be withdrawn if found roaming around campus



BREAK TIME PROCEDURES

CARE OF THE CAMPUS

- Northside takes great pride in the cleanliness of its campuses
- Student Responsibilities
 - Respect the pride of the campus
 - Assist in keeping the Evening High School campus clean
 - Do not leave trash on the tables
 - in the snack bar
 - on the grounds of the patio area
 - Place all trash in the **trash receptacles**
- Consequences for failing to keep the campus clean
 - Students **will lose their break**
 - Breaks are a **privilege** and can and will be taken away



SECURITY SYSTEM

- Security cameras
 - An additional feature that EHS provides for its students
 - Are a deterrent for anyone who might violate NISD policy
 - Or who might violate EHS rules
- Every area on the campus is monitored
 - Including the parking lot



PARKING

- Student Parking Lot
 - Students must park in the Student Parking Lot
 - Faces I-410 access road
 - Will be patrolled by the police officer
 - Patrol should provide adequate protection for vehicles
- Students are prohibited from returning to the parking lot during EHS hours
 - Enter the building immediately upon arrival to EHS
 - **Parking lot is OFF LIMITS during class hours**
 - including during break time
