-Credits

Students may earn ½ credit each session. Credit is limited to one semester each session. All students must clear through the EHS secretary, and all issued textbooks must be returned before credit is awarded. **Failure to clear will result in grade and credit being withheld.**

5:30 - 8:30 PM Three nights per week (Except summer term)

-Attendance
