

Alternative High School Rules

The rules at the Northside Alternative High School are very different from the rules at the regular school. It is mandatory that each student follow these rules and regulations while attending the Northside Alternative High School.

1. NISD will provide transportation to and from the school and the student's residence. District Co-co/Work Program students may receive special permission to drive. These students will turn in their car keys to the office before school each morning.
2. When students arrive at school, they will walk quietly to the cafeteria for breakfast and study hall.
3. Students will walk in an orderly manner from one area to another on campus. There is NO talking.
4. When students enter a classroom they will sit in their assigned seats and take out their Assignment Sheets along with other materials they will need. Students will sit up and do all work that is assigned. Talking on campus is limited to class discussions.
5. NO cell phones are allowed on campus. See page C-8 of the Student-Parent Handbook.
6. Students who fail to complete class assignments will face disciplinary action.
7. Parents will sign, and students must return the following: Daily Assignments Sheet and the NAHS Weekly Progress Report.
8. Students are allowed to bring backpacks for their personal property. Girls are not permitted to bring purses to school. There are NO lockers at NAHS.
9. Students will eat meals in the Cafeteria – and there is NO talking in the Cafeteria.
10. Student will speak to the NAHS staff in a courteous manner.
11. Students must have permission to use the restroom and sign in and out on the restroom log prior to entering and after leaving the restroom. There must be no more than one student in the restroom at a time.
12. Absences from school are excused only when a note is brought from the court or a doctor. No other excuses are accepted. With a note from the court or a doctor the day is not considered a successful day and it must be made up. A parent or guardian must call the school by 10:00 if the child is to be absent. All tardies are unexcused!
13. Students may not use any form of tobacco at the school. They may not bring tobacco, matches, lighters, etc. to school.
14. Students will stay off their home campus as well as all NISD facilities at all times while they are assigned to the Northside Alternative High School. Students are not allowed to participate in any extra-curricular activities.
15. Students are expected to obey all school and district rules and regulations. Failure to follow these rules and NAHS regulations will result in a disciplinary action.
16. NAHS has a more restrictive dress code. Rules concerning dress, will be discussed at enrollment.
17. To meet CRITERIA and return to your home campus, a student must:
Complete the assigned days.
Have no major discipline problems.
