Uniform Dress Code Policy 2006-2007

Colors:

Boys - Black or beige/tan khaki pants with a red polo shirt

Girls - Black or beige/tan khaki pants, A-line skirt, pleated skirt or A-line jumper with a red polo shirt.

Guidelines for Pants:

Black or beige/tan khaki color only

No black or beige/tan jeans, "carpenter/painter" pants, hip-huggers, or stretch pants.

Straight leg only - "Baggies", "Wide", "Extra Wide", "Bell Bottoms", and **form fitting or tight pants are not an option.**

Pants must be the correct waist size

If pants have belt loops, a belt must be worn

Belt must fit and be contained within belt loops (no loose end hanging down)

No cargo pockets, cuffs or drawstrings.

No logos or brand names on exterior

Must have at least a one-inch hem. (**No slits in pants allow**)

Pants must be worn at the waist so proper fit is achieved in the crotch and leg length

Options: Pleats, elastic in waist

Guideline for Skirts and Jumpers (for girls only):

Must be black or beige/tan khaki color only (**No stretch skirts**)

A-line or pleated skirt, A-line jumper

Length mid-thigh or longer

Skirts or jumpers must fit properly (not excessively tight or loose)

No straight skirts

At least a one inch-hem

No buttons down the front or back

No slits

No logos or brand name on exterior

No shorts or skorts

Options: Side pockets, elastic waist

Guidelines for Shirts:

Red polo style with a collar

Long enough to tuck in

No logos or brand names on exterior

May have short or long sleeves

Textured or smooth finish

Mock turtlenecks/T-shirts may be worn under uniform shirt, undergarment shirts must be solid red, black, white, or gray.

Must be thick enough material to not see through.

Guidelines for Outer Wear:

Solid red, black, white or gray sweaters, wind jackets, and sweatshirts (any style) may be worn in addition to the **uniform in the classroom.**

No other outerwear may be worn in the classroom.

No logos or brand name on exterior.

Oversized shirts over the uniform are **not** permitted.

Windbreakers, coats, and jackets of any color are acceptable for **outside the classroom.**

These items should not have any profanity, obscenity or gang graffiti on the exterior.

Guidelines for Headwear:

The following are **not allowed** on the campus: bandanas, beanies, visors, caps, hats, dew-rags, hoods

Guidelines for Earrings:

Girls – Permitted in accordance with Section D of the Student /Parent Handbook

Boys – One stud earring may be worn in each ear. No hoops or any other type of earring is permitted.
