COVID 19 PROTOCOLS

- Masks must be worn properly (must cover nose and mouth) at all times
- Proper social distancing should be followed (3' between groups)
- Hand sanitizing stations will be available for use
- Restroom facilities will be monitored to meet COVID-19 compliance
- Water fountains will be unavailable
- Dugouts/team benches will be sanitized according to UIL guidelines
- PA Announcer will provide announcements regarding expectations of behavior, including COVID 19 recommendations
- ONLY Water/Soft Drinks are allowed in facility
- Concession stand will be unavailable for events

TEAM GUIDELINES

- Coaches are responsible to follow their COVID 19 screening protocols and UIL guidelines
- Masks must be worn properly (must cover nose and mouth – when applicable)
- Coaches must enforce COVID 19 protocols including social distancing (when applicable)
- Coaches will maintain their groups in the designated areas and follow COVID 19 protocols
- Coaches will communicate with game administrator for additional requests

GAME PERSONNEL ARRIVAL

- All game personnel will enter through main entrance.
- All game personnel will submit to temperature screening and provide their COVID 19 screening surveys via Dr. Owl application. *QR Code will be available for efficiency of screening methodology.
- All game personnel are expected to wear masks properly (covering nose and mouth) and follow all COVID 19 protocols

SPECTATORS

- All spectators will enter through main entrance and submit to temperature screening.
- Spectators will provide their COVID 19 screening surveys via Dr. Owl application.
*QR Code will be available for efficiency of screening methodology. (**QR code provided)
- Spectators will present tickets to gate personnel for entry. (tickets to be purchased via online ticket sales provided by designated home team: no tickets will be sold on site)
- Re-entry will not be allowed
- Spectators may enter facility with bottled water or soft drinks only.
- No concession stands will be available
- No outside food allowed (including flower seeds), with the exception of bottled water and/or soft drinks.
- Spectators must use the designated seating areas and follow COVID 19 protocols throughout the event.
- Unsportsmanlike behavior by spectators will not be tolerated. Anyone exhibiting unsportsmanlike behavior towards officials, players, coaches or other spectators will be removed from stadium.
- Presence on the field prior to, during and after the game is prohibited.
- Live animals are prohibited from entering stadium, including pets.
- Balloons and/or confetti are prohibited.
- Smoking or use of tobacco products is prohibited.
- Any situations which arise, and are seen by stadium administration as detrimental to the game atmosphere, potentially dangerous or which cause damage to the stadium are prohibited and will be dealt with accordingly.

Field/Dugout/Batting Cage Guidelines

- The use of tobacco, sunflower seeds and chewing gum is prohibited.
- Only water will be allowed on the field/dugout.
- No colored drinks may be used on the field/dugout
- Absolutely no glass bottles, cans, or food are allowed on the field/dugout
- No cannons, noisemakers or confetti are allowed on the field/dugout
- Spectators will not be allowed on the field before, during or after the game.

STADIUM CAPACITY AS OF MAY 10, 2021: 600 total spectators *must maintain 3' social distance between groups
