Dear Seniors and Parents:

Beard Elementary School, which opened in 2003, was named after Bob Beard—one of the pioneers of the Northside School District. His service on the Board of Trustees from 1967 to 1974 helped transform NISD. His visionary leadership, his focus on educational opportunities, and his spirit of community were just a few of the admirable qualities that led to his becoming a school namesake. The students of Beard loved his frequent visits and his eternally positive and encouraging attitude. Mr. Beard was very proud of his Beard Buckaroos, and Beard Elementary School is honored to carry his name.

Market Day is the annual community service project conducted by the third grade classes at Bob Beard. Each third grader implements the lessons learned during their economics unit as they plan, produce, and sell a homemade craft to the other students at the school. The funds collected from the sale are used to benefit the Beard community. When Mr. Beard passed away in March of 2011, the third grade teachers decided to use Market Day money to fund a scholarship in his memory. This scholarship was awarded for the first time in 2012.

In order to receive a Bob Beard Memorial Scholarship, a student must mail or hand-deliver the attached application by the due date and be selected by the scholarship committee. Applications are available in the high school counselors' offices beginning in January. The application is also posted on the Beard website. Winners will be notified in mid-April and presented with their scholarships at the fifth grade town meeting on Thursday, May 30, 2019.

The criteria for receiving a Bob Beard Memorial Scholarship are listed below. The recipient must:

1. Be graduating from a Northside ISD high school;
2. Have attended Bob Beard Elementary School for at least 3 years, including 3rd grade;
3. Be pursuing post-secondary education;
4. Complete this application and submit it on or before the deadline of **March 8, 2019**.

The monetary value of the Bob Beard Memorial Scholarship is **\$1,000.00**. Two scholarships will be awarded this year. Checks will be issued to the post-secondary school designated by the recipient.
