We also want you to feel comfortable being at the school. We are always looking for ways to include our parents. A few ideas to stay involved are:

### **Dismissal Options**

- ⇒ Ride the Bus—Students riding the bus must go directly and quickly to the bus loop. Buses typically leave campus by 3:48 PM (this allows 8 minutes to get to the bus)
- ⇒ Walk Home—Students walking home must leave campus IM-MEDIATELY. If they need to cross Silent Sunrise, there is a crosswalk in front of the school and we will have someone monitoring from the sidewalk.
- ⇒ Parent Pick-up—Please be patient and cautious. Students will wait for you in the front of the school. We ask that you pull all the way forward, even if this means you have to drive past where your child is standing. This is the most efficient and safe method for this process. In the event of rain, we will modify this to allow students to stay under the covered areas.
- ⇒ ALL STUDENTS MUST BE OFF CAMPUS BY 4:15. Any students still on campus after 4:15 must be in a supervised activity. All others will be asked to leave campus.
- ⇒ LEARNING TREE reminder—The Learning Tree program is designed to meet the needs of children and support the goals and objectives of both Northside and the Texas Education Agency. The Learning Tree program provides academic and enrichment activities, enhanced self-motivation, social skills, and improved study skills.
