

Holiday Hands!



I have seen different variations and versions of this on Pinterest. You can make this as simple or as elaborate as you and your loved ones want. (We went kind of elaborate). :)

We chose four pieces of holiday scrapbook paper, a simple shadow box, and some jingle bells. First each of us took our piece of paper had our hand traced (The fact that this tickles made it a bit of a challenge for our little one).

Second you cut out each hand.

Third you glue the largest hand on to the remaining piece of paper, then the next one, and the next. The smallest hand should be the final one glued down.

Fourth you attach (usually pin or glue) your creation to the inside of the back of the shadow box. Fifth you put the holiday item (we chose jingle bells), in the inside of the shadow box frame itself. Last you set the backing in and latch it into place.



Larger families can fan out the hand (some people do it like a wreath, others like a line with the hands in order from biggest to smallest).

My daughter has already said she wants to do this again, but with our hand cut outs in a regular picture frame for beside her bed. She also talks about laminating it, and hole punching it, so it can be in her binder at school. :)

You can do which ever one sounds like the most fun for you and your loved ones!
