

HARLAN HS FAQ's

Q: Where can I drop off my student before school?

A: Students may be dropped off in the front of the building, or near the gym or auditorium.

Q: Where can my student go in the mornings?

A: Library, Cafeteria, Courtyard, Gym, and Auditorium Areas.

Q: Where is the bus loop located?

A: The bus loop is located behind the cafeteria.

Q: How can I check my student's grades and attendance?

A: Through the Home Access Center (HAC) at <https://portalupdate.nisd.net/>

Q: What dress code items are prohibited?

A: The following items are prohibited: Shorts, facial piercings, pants with major holes, costumes, undershirts/muscle shirts, pajamas, see through or low cut tops, graphic or inappropriate language on clothing, non-natural hair colors. Skirt length must be no more than four inches above the knee.

Q: Is there a supply list for each grade level or content area?

A: Each teacher will communicate what supplies are needed the first days of school. Students are asked to bring something to write with and write on the first day.

Q: Where can my student obtain a parking permit?

A: Parking permits will be given out during Prep Days (8/15 & 8/16) or in the VP office during the school year before school or during lunch. Permits are \$20 each; students must be listed as an insured driver on the insurance policy.

Q: Can my student leave campus during lunch?

A: Harlan will be a closed campus for the 2017-18 school year. Students may not leave campus unless they are signed out by an individual listed on their emergency card.

Q: Who do I contact if I have transportation questions?
