



## A Letter from the Coaches



Dear Parents,

We would like to welcome all of you to the Krueger Elementary Physical Education department. Mr. Villarreal and Mr. Piernik will be your child's Physical Education teachers for the 2017-2018 school year. Together we plan on having a safe and fun filled experience.

Our philosophy is to teach students to learn cognitively, affectively and physically through the various activities. The primary grades (K-2) will concentrate on activities such as general and personal space, rhythmic activities, catching and throwing, striking and kicking and manipulatives. The intermediate grades (3-5) will be focusing on basic motor skills such as throwing, kicking, volleying, and striking in order to use skills in games and sports. Recreational activities, nutrition habits and teamwork skills will also be implemented to encourage lifelong skills, healthy choices and responsible students.

All students will be starting with an S for participation and an S for behavior. Your son/daughter will have the opportunity to improve this grade to an E for both excellent behavior and participation while in Physical education class. On the flipside your son/daughter will earn a N or U due to inappropriate behavior and/or non-participation.

Due to the nature of activities in physical education, it is appropriate and recommended that students wear tennis shoes or rubber soled shoes while participating.
