

Jordan Middle School Dress Code

We enforce our dress code as outlined in the Parent/Student Handbook.

Dress code violations will result in a request for parents to bring a change of clothing, changing into school issued clothes, and/or disciplinary consequences.

Tops

When arms are raised, the bottom of your shirt should touch the top of your pants.

All shirts must have sleeves.

Graphic designs must have appropriate wording and pictures.

Strapless shirts, spaghetti straps, crop tops, sleeveless shirts, and muscle tees are not allowed.



Bottoms

All bottoms must be worn at the waist.

No sagging.

The length of shorts must be mid-thigh or lower.

Rips, tears, and holes should be mid-thigh or lower. Bottoms with holes larger than a fist are prohibited. Tight fitting spandex, leggings, biker shorts, etc are prohibited.

Pajama bottoms are prohibited.



Footwear

Appropriate foot wear must be worn.

Slides and flip-flops are NOT allowed.

Tennis shoes must be worn in PE.



Headwear

Headwear is not allowed to be worn at school, such as hoodies, caps, beanies, bandanas, etc.

Body piercings are prohibited except for rings, studs, or other traditional jewelry.

Hair must be neat and clean.

Unconventional piercings, jewelry, and hairstyles that distract from teaching and learning are prohibited.
