



FOUR IMPORTANT THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- 1. The student must have 3 or fewer absences for the second semester excluding school business and Health absences in the exempted course.
- 2. The student's semester average is 80 or higher.
- 3. The student's conduct grade in that class is "S" or better.
- 4. The student must attend during the scheduled exam time.

Help Your Child's School Prevent the Spread of Infections

You can play an important role in helping your child have a healthy place to learn. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) developed guidance for schools to help students, families, and school staff keep kids healthy and learning. Here are some ways you can help your child's school stop the spread of germs:



- **1.**Encourage your child to practice healthy habits, like washing their hands often and covering their mouth and nose when coughing and sneezing.
- 2. Make sure your child goes for their yearly check-ups and gets the recommended routine vaccines they need. This helps keep your child healthy and in school by reducing the spread of germs in school and making sickness shorter and milder.
- **3.**Know when your child is well enough to go to school and when they should stay home because of their symptoms. Some reasons to have your child stay home include fever, vomiting, diarrhea, and respiratory symptoms that are getting worse or not improving. Guidance on staying home when sick can also help you decide whether your child needs to stay home. Ask your child's school if they have specific policies for returning after being sick.





- **4.**Help make decisions about how your child's school is preventing illness, by taking steps for cleaner air, for example. You can join a school or district committee such as a school health advisory committee (SHAC), wellness committee, or parent teacher association (PTA). These committees help set the policies for health and wellness, work to include language about infections in school policies and practices and inform emergency operations and recovery plans.
- **5.**Volunteer for school or community activities that support a healthy education environment. You can also attend, or support meetings and training events offered by your child's school or district to learn more about how schools can help prevent the spread of infections.




STEVENS HIGH SCHOOL Dress Code



- 1. Shorts must reach mid-thigh length
- 2. Skirts, skorts, and dresses must reach mid-thigh length. There should not be a cut or slit in the clothing that extends above the mid-thigh.
- 3. Appropriate footwear must be worn; footwear which has toes reinforced with steel, hard plastics or similar materials are specifically prohibited.
- 4. Hair must be neat and clean. Hairstyles that distract from teaching and learning will be prohibited.
- 5. Tank tops, muscle shirts, halter/crop tops, spaghetti straps, exposed backs or midriffs, and see-through garments are prohibited.
- 6. Indecent/inappropriate patches, writings, or drawings on clothing are prohibited. Undergarments must not be visible.
- 7. All pants are to be worn at the waist (no "sagging").
- 8. No spandex pants, shorts, skirts, dresses, or bodysuits are allowed.
- 9. Frays or holes in jeans/pants that are above the knees are prohibited.
- 10. Any clothes that are suggestive or indecent clothing or any clothing which causes a distraction will be prohibited.

Código de vestimenta



- 1. Los pantalones cortos deben llegar hasta la mitad del muslo.
- 2. Las faldas, falda pantalón y vestidos deben llegar hasta la mitad del muslo. No debe haber ningún corte o hendidura en la ropa que se extienda por encima de la mitad del muslo.
- 3. Se deberá utilizar calzado adecuado; Está expresamente prohibido el calzado que tenga la puntera reforzada con acero, plástico duro o materiales similares.
- 4. El cabello debe estar limpio y aseado. Se prohibirán los peinados que distraigan de la enseñanza y el aprendizaje.
- 5. Están prohibidas las camisetas sin mangas, camisetas sin mangas, camisetas cortas o sin mangas, tirantes finos, espaldas o abdomen expuestos y prendas transparentes.
- 6. Están prohibidos los parches, escritos o dibujos indecentes/inapropiados en la ropa. La ropa interior no debe ser visible.
- 7. Todos los pantalones deben usarse a la cintura (sin "flacidez").
- 8. No se permiten pantalones, pantalones cortos, faldas, vestidos o monos de spandex.
- 9. Se prohíben los deshilachados o agujeros en los jeans/pantalones que están por encima de las rodillas.
- 10. Se prohibirá cualquier vestimenta que sea sugerente, indecente o que cause distracción.
