


Important Dates

During the first week of October, Luna students and staff will practice an Active Threat Lockdown according to the NISD Standard Response Protocol.


PTA meeting-September 17, 6-7 PM in cafeteria

HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT AND ATTENDANCE INFORMATION

Important information about 7th and 8th grade students enrolled in High School Credit Courses:

Many of our 7th and 8th grade students are enrolled in high school credit courses. There is an important attendance requirement that students must be present "in-person" for 90% of class and have a passing grade of 70 or higher in order to receive credit.

Students enrolled in a year long course can have no more than 17 absences for the year.

Students enrolled in a semester long course can have no more than 7 absences for the 1st semester or 10 absences in the 2nd semester.

Your child will be required to complete attendance recovery in person at Luna if they accrue too many absences in order to maintain their credit with a minimum passing grade of 70.

This year, Attendance Recovery (AR) will only be available on campus and "in-person".

Luna will provide Attendance Recovery dates in the near future.

Aug./September Guidance

6th Grade - Counselors visited 6th grade the week of August 26th. We helped students understand what resources the counselors provide on campus and introduced students to positive self-talk. Book of the month: "Woo Hoo! You're Doing Great!" by Sandra Boynton

7th Grade - Counselors visited 7th grade the week of September 10th. We reminded students understand what resources the counselors provide on campus and worked with students on the skill of grounding. Book of the month: "I'm Stuck: by Julia Mills

8th Grade - Counselors will be visiting 8th grade the week on Sept. 17th. We will be reminding students of the resources counselors provide to students on campus and working on understanding how high school credits affect GPA and the importance of attendance in receiving credit.

Upcoming: In October we will have our campus wide Respect and Longhorns against Bullying initiative. Students and faculty will sign the Decision of Respect on Oct. 4th.

Schedule Changes: We have made it to our 5th week of school! Scheduling errors have been completed. Any parent or student wishing to request a schedule change will need to complete a schedule change form and obtain the written permission of the Associate Principal and/or Academic Dean. All schedule changes start with a face to face parent teacher conference.
