Northside Independent School District GUIDELINES FOR FOREIGN EXCHANGE AGENCIES

According to Board Policy, a student shall be admitted if he/she is a foreign exchange student placed with a host family that resides in the district by a foreign exchange program affiliated with CSIET. All foreign exchange student applications are processed by the Office of Student Advocacy and School Choice. NISD will begin accepting applications the first day of the second semester for the following school year. NISD will accept five (5) students per high school for the 2024-25 school year. Only complete applications will be reviewed. If an application is incomplete, we will contact the Foreign Exchange program, but the student will not be on the list until a complete packet is submitted for review.

APPLICATION: Please verify the application you send to the Office of Student Advocacy and School Choice is complete and is sent as a PDF attachment to SASC@nisd.net. Do not mail or fax. Completed applications shall be processed in the order in which they are received. Please allow 5 business days for the application to be processed.
