## Attendance

- **★** Texas Compulsory Attendance Law
  - In order to earn credits, students must be in the classroom 90% of the time.
    - No more than 8 absences (Semester 1).
    - No more than 9 absences (Semester 2).
    - No more than 17 total absences for YL courses.
    - No more than 5 minutes tardy/leaving early.
- ★ If you exceed the number of absences, you'll have to complete attendance recovery. This includes excused and unexcused absences.

## Attendance

- **★** Attendance Recovery
  - Attendance recovery must happen with your teacher.
    This may look like before or after school tutoring or work to complete before or after school.
- ★ According to the TCA law, after you miss 25% of the school year, you are no longer eligible for attendance recovery and must retake the course.
  - Sem 1- 20 days until automatic loss of credit
  - Sem 2- 23 days until automatic loss of credit
