

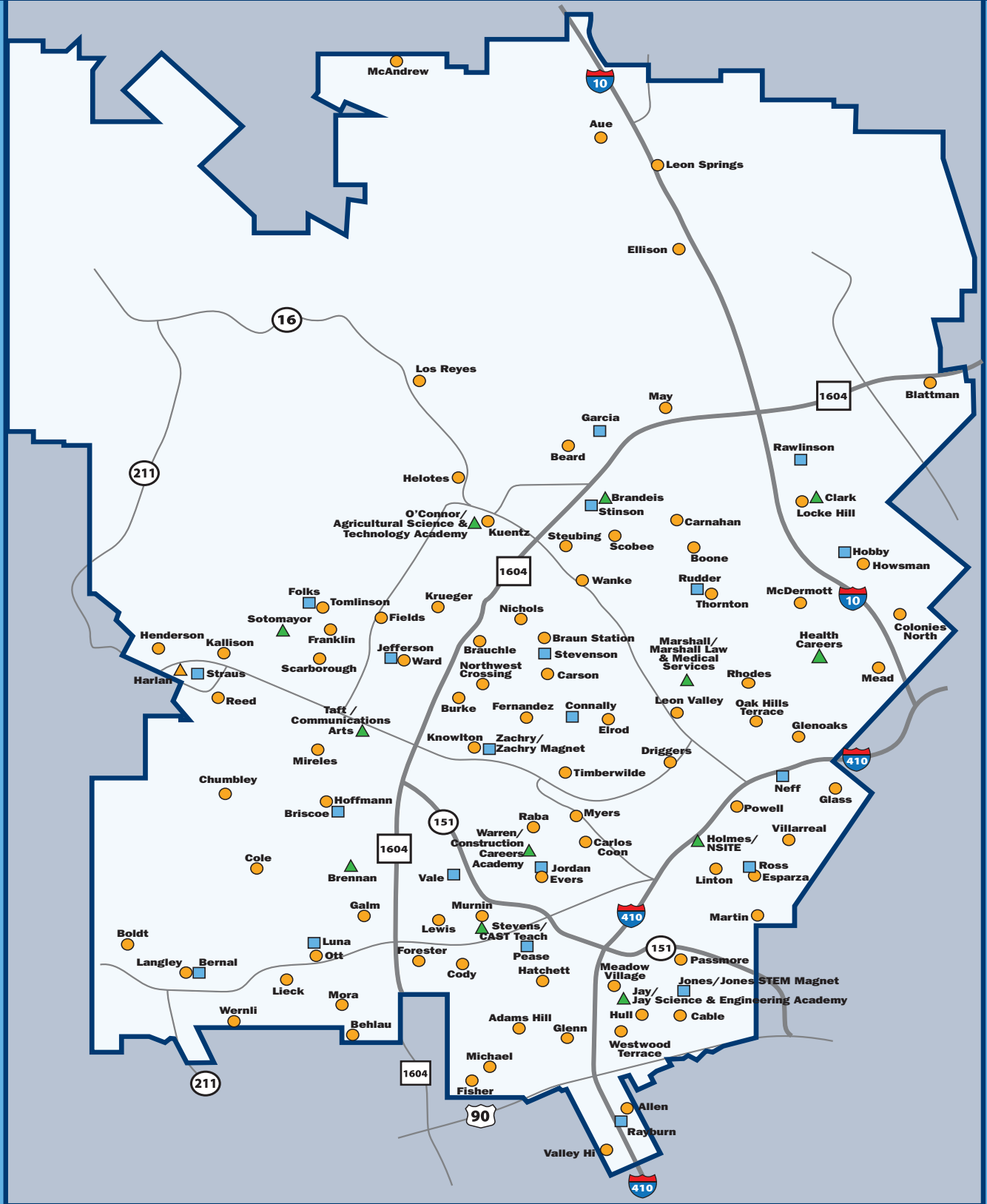

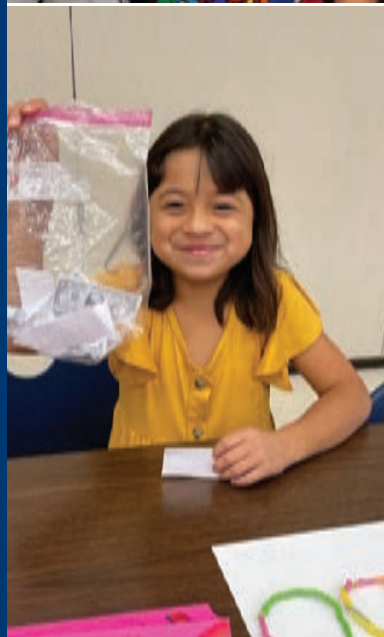

## STEM Labs

Each elementary campus features STEM Labs, offering students hands-on learning in science, technology, and engineering. These labs provide dedicated time for exploration and creation, introducing students to coding and robotics. Our emphasis on perseverance and a growth mindset prepares students for future academic and career choices by allowing them the space to make corrections and improve upon their work.

## Gifted and Talented Program

At NISD, we believe in recognizing and nurturing every student's potential. Our Elementary Gifted and Talented (GT) program empowers young minds with advanced intellectual abilities. Each campus is equipped with a full-time GT Specialist who orchestrates a variety of services, including pullout sessions that foster creative and independent thinking. Our curriculum is specially designed to align with the Texas State Plan for Gifted/Talented Education, providing an environment where gifted students can thrive both intellectually and socially.

## Fine Arts

Fine Arts instruction is integral to our elementary curriculum, allowing students to create and imagine. Certified art and music specialists teach a TEKS-driven curriculum across all district elementary campuses. Students engage in multiple hands-on opportunities to develop a joy for singing, dancing, playing musical instruments, and creating 2-D and 3-D art pieces. Our elementary art and music programs are highly visible and involve all students, fostering skills that contribute to the whole child's future success.

At Northside, we believe in fostering imagination and creativity, making a meaningful impact not just within our community but across our city, state, and nation.

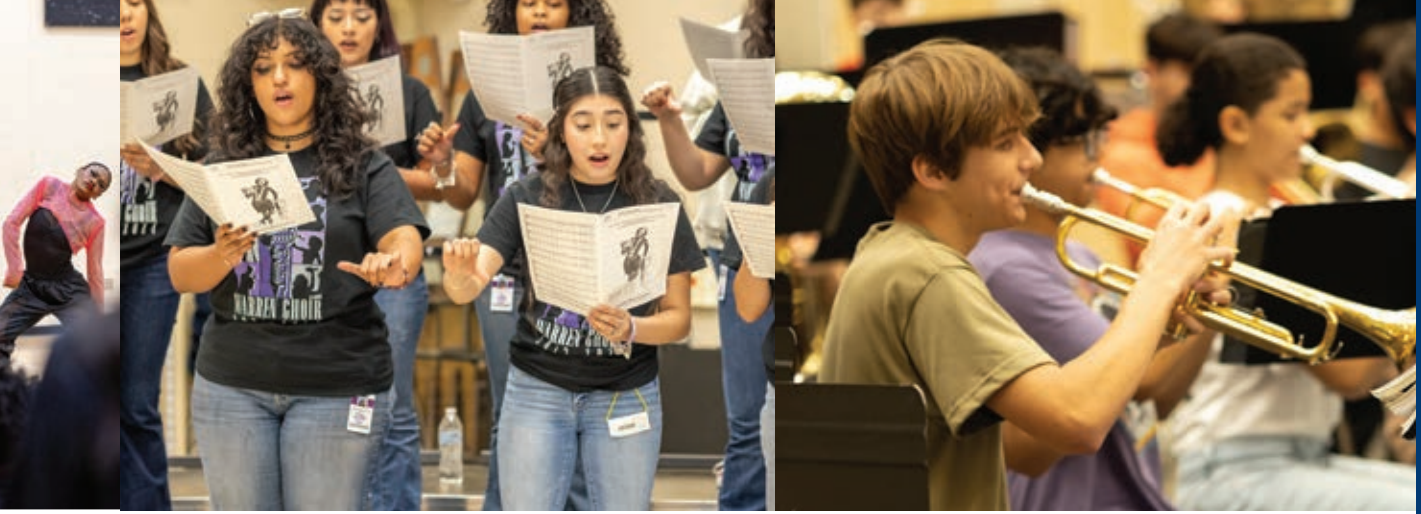

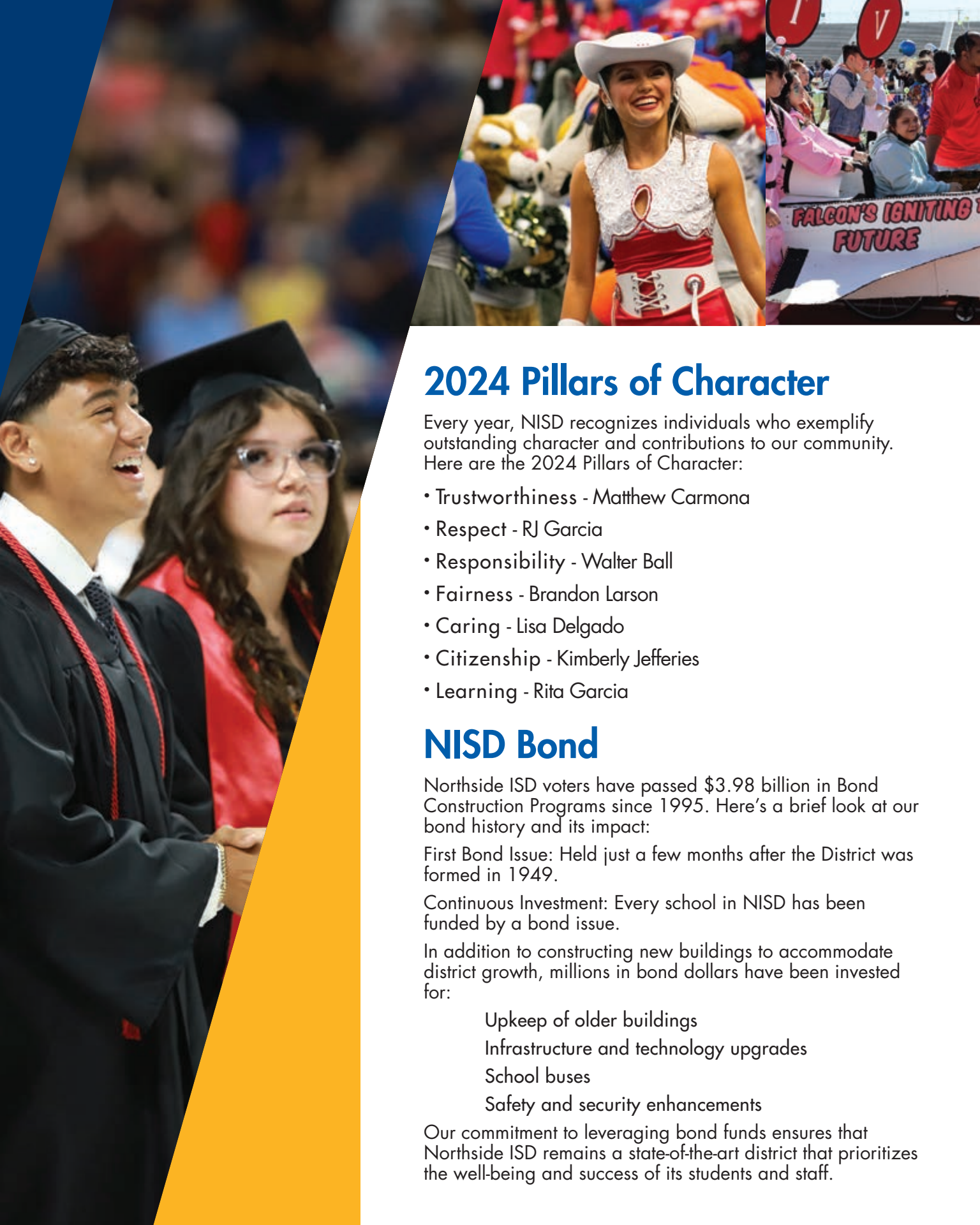

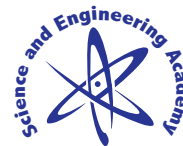
