



# Financial Repercussions


- Minor in possession of tobacco new age is 21 as of September 1, 2019. The law is now worded as a minor commits an offense if they possess, purchase, consume, or accept a cigarette, e-cigarette, or tobacco product.
- Also, the exception for use in the presence of a parent, guardian or spouse has been removed.
   You can still be charged even if a parent "approves" of the tobacco use.

# Minor in Possession of Tobacco Class C Misdemeanor Fine: \$100 Minor has to attend an e-cigarette and tobacco awareness program. Lost day(s) of work


# **Criminal Implications**


Children between the ages of 10 and 16 years of age can be charged with a crime.

At the age of 17, the person will be charged as an adult.


