Northside ISD offers a Life Skills Curriculum to provide the skills students need to make healthy choices, stay drug-free, and set positive goals for themselves and their future. Though not required, your child may participate in the program while placed in the Northside Disciplinary Alternative Education Program (DAEP).

Successful participation in the RESET program requires the child to be actively engaged in learning and to maintain satisfactory behavior and attendance. A student who meets criteria may be eligible to return to their regular campus in approximately 15 successful days.

Please be advised that the DAEP assignment may be extended by a few days due to high school semester exams, state or district standardized testing, RESET class scheduling, and/or time of year to include end-of-semester or end-of-school year assignments.

Parent & Student Expectations

The student is expected to participate in a cycle of six sessions over a three-week period. Student sessions are held during the school day and range from 45 to 60 minutes. Only one absence is allowed.

The participation of the parents is viewed as a key element leading to a child's overall success. Evening sessions are offered twice a week and parents will have three weeks to complete four sessions. The sessions are approximately 90 minutes in length. Individuals who arrive late might not receive credit for the evening.

Failure to adhere to the above-mentioned expectations by both the student and the parent(s) will result in the child serving the initial 30-day placement at DAEP.
