

Frequently Asked Questions

1. If I am an in-district (attend NISD) does my counselor have to approve my courses.

Yes-you home campus counselor will have to approve any classes you take during summer school.

2. If I am an out of district student (do not attend NISD) does my counselor have to approve my courses.

You may take any course with us that we offer, however it will be your responsibility to ensure it meets your campus/school graduation requirements.

3. How will I get my report card?

We will issue them to the student via in person or through the mail system. If you do not receive one please contact the NISD principal or vice principal for summer school. Central office/district personnel will not have access to this and will not be able to help you with these.

4. We are planning a trip that will require missing a week of summer school. Will this be excused?

No-if more than three days are missed, the student will be dropped from the program and a refund will not be issued.

5. If I have registered for summer school and paid, but I cannot attend will I be issued a refund?

We know that sometimes circumstances keep you from the best laid plans. If you have paid then you will be issued a refund but you must notify the summer school office during June 18-21 for the first semester and during July 16-19. We will process the refunds on June 26 and July 25.

6. I missed the registration day for summer school. Can I still register?

Yes-you can still register on the first day of summer school. Please note that we will not start the registration process until 9:30 on June 18. Please note that there will be a wait during this time. We highly encourage that you attend on the registration day, June 14.

7. If I registered for one class and would like to change it?

You may change your class that you registered for prior to the first day of summer school (June 18). If you are an in-district student (attend NISD) then you must have your counselor's approval.

8. If summer school is over and I still have a question about the courses took, who should I contact?

Even though summer school is over, you will still contact the principal of summer school. The fastest way to make contact is via email. This can be found on your informational, registration page found on the NISD homepage.
