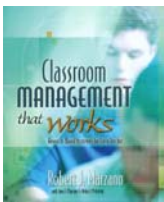

### ***Classroom Management That Works: Research-Based Strategies for Every Teacher***

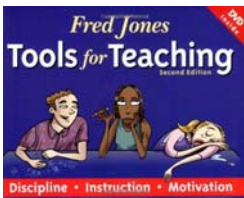
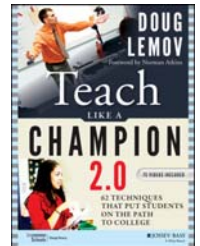

### ***Tools for Teaching: Discipline, Instruction, Motivation***

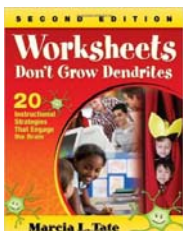
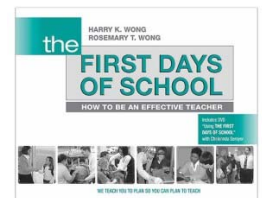
